

This is a reminder about the start of summer school tomorrow, Tuesday, June 1st.

K-8 summer classes are from 8 AM to 11 AM, June 1st to July 1st, Monday through Thursday at Hardin County School. Car riders can be dropped off in front of the school at 7:55 AM for their 8 AM class. Breakfast will be served each day and a lunch meal will be sent home with the students. The school nurse will be available during summer school hours just as she is during the regular school year.

At 11 AM, elementary car riders will be picked up around the side of the school building by the outside gym and junior high car riders will be picked up at the high school door on the east end of the building just as we did during the regular school year. Parents/Guardians picking up students should line up in the bus parking lot as usual and wait for their student's turn in line and then proceed around the building. Traffic around the building is one way when students are present. You must enter around the west side (elementary side) and exit around the east side (high school side) of the building. The buses will be parked out front as usual waiting to load students who will be riding the bus home each day.

Tomorrow is also the first day for the credit recovery program at SIC for students in grades 9-12. The SIC program is from June 1st to June 24th, Monday through Thursday. The class times are 8:30 AM to 12:30 PM and 12:30 PM to 4:30 PM. The bus that will be going to SIC will begin picking up students at 7 AM in order to get students to their 8:30 AM classes on time. Upon arrival, students should go to the cafeteria to meet Mr. Tyler Billman who will direct you to your classrooms.
